



Crime Free Multi-Housing Train the Trainer

If your agency has a Crime Free Multi-Housing Program or is interested in starting one, this training is for you. Any agency that needs more instructors for Crime Free, has added more members to their Crime Free Unit, has a new Crime Free Coordinator taking over the unit or is interested in starting the program from scratch must complete this 2-day Train the Trainer course. This mandatory training has limited seats and is only hosted twice a year.

This program is nationally and internationally used to help law enforcement agencies work cooperatively with their rental communities to reduce instances of crime, calls for service, and nuisance. Students will be certified to implement, teach and supervise their Crime Free Multi-Housing program.

- **Instructing landlords on the court system**
- **Applicant screening**
- **Abatement**
- **Crime Free Lease Addendum**
- **Active property management**
- **Developing a crime prevention approach**
- **C.P.T.E.D. (Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design) education**
- **Federal Fair Housing Laws/ JHO/ RLTO**
